



Sunrise Commodity Update: April 2007

Sugar: The sugar market is down significantly from the summer highs of 2006. Both the World and domestic markets are down. It appears that sugar will continue to trade in a narrow range for the next several months.

Corn Syrup: The word in this market is ethanol. New plants to produce ethanol are opening every month with more on the drawing board. Prices on corn continue to be firm in the \$4.00 range. The USDA will be releasing corn planting intentions shortly and this number will impact the market.
